Each and every case will be ordered to a specific number of jury duties ranging from two (2) to six (6) separate Court appearances.

The possibility exists to order the defendant to apologize personally or by letter to a victim and/or parents, write a related essay and to order any restitution should it be determined. Each defendant may be ordered to take one or more of the life skills classes, (The Law and You; The Buck Stops Here, or Choices). If not ordered, the Judge or the Coordinator may recommend classes for the defendant or any defendant may choose to participate in the life skills classes and receive double credit for class time towards their community service.

All Minor Consumption and Drug related cases will attend a mandatory 10 hour alcohol/drug awareness class at their own expense. All smoking violations must attend a tobacco class at their own expense.
